PE

All children must have a minimum of 2 hours PE per week in school. Please ensure that your child is sent to school with the correct equipment. If your child forgets their kit, they will be expected to take part in their uniform, unless their shoes are not suitable for physical activity.

School Uniform.

We have high expectations for all our pupils. Please ensure that they wear the correct uniform at all times:

- Black shoes or trainers.
- White shirts, T-Shirts or polo shirts
- Grey skirt or trousers. Children in EYFS may wear grey jogging bottoms.
- Head scarves should only be black or white and the type that can be slipped on.
- Jewellery: only small gold or silver stud/sleeper earrings are permitted. No other jewellery is allowed in school.
- Nail varnish is not permitted in school.
- Children from Year 4 up may bring their own pencil case. We also encourage them to bring their own notebook. No erasers/ rubbers are allowed in school as mistakes are part of learning.

Packed Lunches

Children choosing not to have a school dinner can bring a healthy packed lunch.

No fizzy drinks, crisps or chocolate bars

are allowed. • **Puddings;** should be fruit based such as fruit salad, tinned fruit with yoghurt or custard, fruity rice pudding, fruit smoothies, fruit based crumble, 1 small cake bar or biscuit.

No food can be heated.

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Medicine in school

Please also make sure that if your child needs an asthma pump or Epipen, that you check they are in date.

Please ensure the office is informed if your child has any allergies.

If your child needs to take prescribed medicine during the school day, please complete a form in the office and leave the medicine with our Admin Team.

Breakfast Club & Play Centre

Breakfast Club is every morning – 8am-8.45am. Fee £1.00 which includes a healthy breakfast.

Play Centre – every evening 3.30-6pm. Fee is £7.00 per night.

If your child attends another sports or arts afterschool club 3.30-4.30pm, and then attends Play Centre, the fee is reduced to £5.00. This does not apply to homework club.

Children must be pre-registered to attend both Breakfast Club and Play Centre and fees must be paid a week in advance.

As you know, schools are expected to run 5 INSET days throughout the school year. After consultation with our staff we have decided to complete most of our INSET days as twilights after school. This will enable the school to close on Friday 15th December at 1.30pm for the Winter Break.
