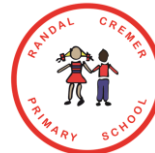

## Attendance Matters!

Dear Parents & Carers: Every half term you will receive an attendance newsletter. This will tell you about expectations and incentives for pupils to reach their attendance target. The Local Authority and The Department of Education set a target for all schools. The attendance target for Randal Cremer is 97%. This is the figure that the whole school must aim for each week. Attendance is closely monitored and incentives will be offered to those who do come to school every day. Please read the information careful.



## Attendance

Did you know that educational success is linked to attendance? That's why we expect high attendance and hence high achievement from all pupils. The parent/ carer of a child with attendance below 95% will be notified in writing.

## Punctuality



Lateness can seriously disrupt your child's learning. The Doors are now opened from 8.50am, pupils can walk straight to their classes. If your child arrives after the gate is closed, they must go to the office to register, where they will receive a late pass.



## Rewards & Incentives



**Nursery & Reception:** On Monday mornings an attendance assembly takes place in the bottom hall, parents are welcome to attend. Three pupils with 100% attendance from the previous week are randomly chosen to receive a prize. The class with the best attendance also receives a certificate.

**Key stage 1& 2:** During Monday assembly, a silver certificate is given to the class with 100% attendance.

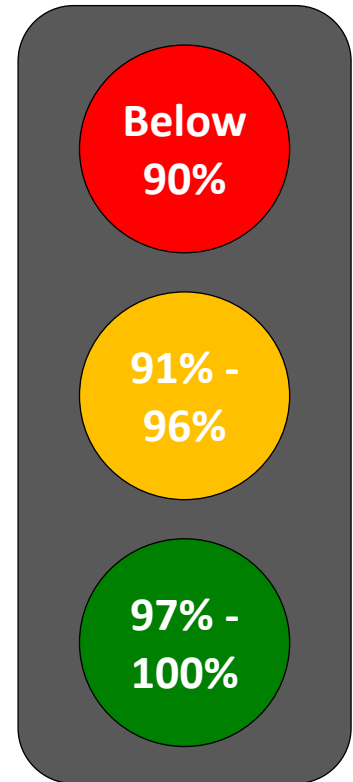
