Key points from our Attendance Policy

Learning: Any absence affects the pattern of a child's schooling and regular absences will seriously affect their learning.

Ensuring your child's regular attendance is your legal responsibility, and permitting absence from school without good reason creates a legal offence which may result in prosecution

Being on Time Matters!

Lateness: Poor punctuality is not acceptable. Missing the start of the day can result in reduced learning, embarrassment and unnecessary absenteeism. You can approach us if you are having problems getting your child to school on time. **Be in the right place at the right Time:** the gate between 8.45am and 8.50am and classroom at 8.55am

Persistent Absenteeism(PA) A child becomes "persist absentee" when they miss 10% or more schooling across the year for whatever reason. Absence at this level is doing considerable damage to any child's education prospects and we need parents' fullest support and co-operation to tackle this. All **PA** cases are automatically referred to the Attendance Officer from The Learning Trust.

Green : 97 – 100%	Safe Zone, Excellent. Keep it up
Amber: 91- 96%	Sliding Zone, improvement needed
Red: 90% and under	Danger Zone
