Attendance & Punctuality Matters



We are aiming high to achieve our attendance target Of 97% and also to keep punctuality attainment high.

The school gates open at 08.45am. Make sure your child attends school every day and on time.

A late card will be given if your child arrives after 08.55am and will be marked as late in the register. If your child arrives after 09.30am, this will be counted as an unauthorised absence mark.

Holidays taken during term times

Pupils are not permitted to take holidays during term time therefore holidays taken can no longer be authorised by the head teacher except in exceptional circumstances. If parents/carers decide to take a holiday or extended leave in term time a Penalty Notice under Section 444 of The Education Act 1996 will be issued.

What is a Penalty Notice?

When a child has more than 14 sessions (7days) of unauthorised absence in a 12 week period, Parents can be issued a fixed Penalty Notice by the Local Authority. The Penalty is £60.00 but rises to £120.00 if paid after 21 days but within 28days.
